Business School Students Visit For Christmas Day




Back in December, in the middle of our snowy season, we hosted two international students, who attend the International Business

Evangelism with Our Church

Since Randall is the deacon with responsibility for evangelism with our international church, we are praying about how to help the church with setting up regular evangelism outreach. One young couple would like to start English instruction as a way to present the gospel to Hungarians. Also, on Saturday, April 13, we have permission from a local Homeless Shelter to hold an outreach. We hope this will be something the members of the church will participate in, and see if God might be calling them to serve the large number of Homeless people in Budapest.

Summer Ministry

This coming summer our family has been invited to help with a summer camp in Montenegro. Please pray God would provide for this event, and that many children and youth would believe in the Lord Jesus, and follow Him as disciples. Also, our international church has expressed an interest in sending a short-term missions team to another country here in Europe. Please pray this possibility would not close, but God would open this door wide and confirm the specifics. Our older two children are finally old enough to attend the Christian summer camp here in our village, so they look forward to this.
